ADMISSION REGULATIONS

The school is open for admission to both boys and girls irrespective of caste, creed or social status.

1. The management reserves to itself the right of admission.
2. A child who has not attained the age of 6 years will not be admitted to class I.
3. Registration for L.K.G. is done in the month of January. The minimum age for admission to L.K.G. is 4 years.
4. New admission will be made subject to the vacancies in each class in the month of April after the annual results.
5. Every new pupil must bring
 - (a) Leaving Certificate from a recognized school.
 - (b) The copy of birth certificate.
 - (c) A passport size photograph
 - (d) Copy of Adhar card.
6. Pupils applying for admission are as a rule subject to an entrance examination held at the February. They must bring their pen, pencils but no special book is required. They will be tested for the standard below the one to which they seek admission. The subjects for the test are English, Mathematics, Science, Social Science & G.K.
7. A candidate who has attended any recognized school cannot be admitted without a leaving certificate from the school last attended. If he/she comes from a school outside the state of Kerala Educational officer or the place in which the school is situated should countersign the Leaving Certificate.
8. School Leaving Certificate will be given to those who have settled all their dues. Application for leaving certificate should be made in writing by the parent.
